GOALS for FUUSN's 2019 Annual Budget Drive

1. Continue and enhance current FUUSN Activities

FUUSN is bursting with valuable activities, and they cost money to run (see charts). We need balanced budgets for long-term stability. Let's do that by growing our revenue rather than cutting our activities!

2. Promote financial security

FUUSN's beautiful sanctuary occasionally requires major repairs. Our recent sewer emergency highlights why we must replenish the building reserve fund, which has been depleted to fund large repair bills over the last few years.

3. Renew our commitment to our denomination and its values


Last year we had a budget crisis that forced us to reduce our contribution to the Unitarian Universalist Association. We want to increase FUUSN's pledge to the denomination, promoting the ideals of Unitarian Universalism across the country at a time when those ideals need our support.

FUUSN Pledges Make It Happen!


Our pledges constitute two-thirds of FUUSN's revenue. We need everyone to step up with significant pledges of support.

GIVING GUIDE for FUUSN's 2019 Annual Budget Drive

To meet FUUSN's target of \$625,000... we need MORE pledges and HIGHER pledges.

What's Your Fair Share? Some issues to consider:

- Making a financial contribution is an expectation of all participants in the FUUSN community We, the people who worship here, form the FUUSN community, participate in activities, and use the facilities, must share in its upkeep.
- FUUSN is more than a charity it is our community FUUSN is not a charity. It is the spiritual community that gives us and our loved ones support, sustenance, and friendship, both in times of celebration and in times of need.
- FUUSN fund drive operates differently than other fund drives you might participate in

Many nonprofits such as NPR or World Wildlife Fund operate on a model that can be sustained from small donations from large numbers of people. FUUSN depends entirely on us as congregants to survive, and requires a substantial commitment from each of us

The cost of keeping FUUSN running exceeds \$2800 per household

FUUSN spends substantially more on each of us than it receives in pledges, using other sources of income.

FUUSN's median pledge is substantially less than the average cost per household

We need more congregants to pledge at the Sustainer level (\$2800 per year) to cover FUUSN's costs. We are very grateful to our fellow congregants who are already digging deep to pledge at the Sustainer, Visionary, and Transformer levels. We hope that many more will be inspired to move up to the next level. If we can increase each level by the numbers below, we will meet the target and keep FUUSN's flame **burning bright**!


